ATTENDANCE

60 clock hours of attendance are required for a make-up course. THE SUMMER SCHOOL WILL NOT RECOMMEND CREDIT FOR THOSE STUDENTS WHO DO NOT MEET THE ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENT OF 60 HOURS. Parents will be notified if students are absent or excessively tardy. In the event of necessary absence, it is the responsibility of the student to arrange make-up with the individual teacher involved. Make-up and extra help is scheduled Fridays from 12:00 to 3:00 p.m. A mid-term progress report will be issued to parents.

ENROLLMENT

- 1) Enrollment shall be on a first come first serve basis
- 2) Courses will start when a minimum of 10 students enroll.
- 3) The School reserves the right to reschedule courses as necessary to accommodate enrollment demand and to meet State regulations. The School reserves the right to cancel any course because of insufficient enrollment.
- 4) In order for the application to be accepted, the course fee must be paid in full.
- 5) Students should report to the first class on July 6.
- 6) Register early. Students will not be enrolled until the completed form and fee are received. **DEADLINE: JULY 2**
- 7) Class lists will be completed and a place in class reserved by July 6. No refunds will be given after July 6, except in the case where a class is not offered because of insufficient enrollment. Before July 6, courses may be canceled, applications withdrawn, and fees refunded. Please allow at least four weeks for refund checks.

CREDITS

The Portland Public School Department, as authorized by the Maine State Department of Education, operates the Portland Summer School.

Pupils who enroll to make up a full year subject previously failed must be enrolled in class sixty clock hours to earn credit. Credits earned in approved secondary schools should be accepted as local school credits by any other approved secondary school in Maine. Acceptance of credit by schools in other states will be determined by those schools. Any student applying for a credit for a credit course should make sure that it meets the requirements of his/her own school. The student should know his/her school's policy regarding credit for Summer School. *The student's guidance counselor (sending school counselor) should be informed and consulted prior to registration.*
