Some of what all students should know and be able to do upon graduation.

### Learner Expectations

#### 1. Collaborative Worker

- work toward the achievement of group goals;
- demonstrate effective interpersonal skills;
- contribute to group maintenance;
- perform a variety of roles within a group.

#### 2. Knowledgeable Person (see the Content Standards)

- have academic knowledge and skills in:  
English/Language Arts, Personal Fitness, Foreign Language, Science, Information Skills,  
Social Studies, Mathematics, Technology, Visual and Performing Arts

#### 3. Effective Communicator

- convey ideas clearly;
- communicate with a variety of audiences;
- communicate for a variety of purposes and in a variety of ways.

#### 4. Quality Producer

- create products which are purposeful and meaningful to an audience;
- create products that exhibit quality;
- demonstrate the habits of continuous improvement;
- be innovative.

#### 5. Involved Citizen

- practice and promotes the rights and responsibilities of citizenship;
- be respectful of individual differences.

#### 6. Self-Directed Learner

- set priorities and goals;
- self-assess progress, evaluates action, and adjusts procedures as needed;
- engage in tasks even when answers or solutions are not immediately apparent;
- view situations outside the boundaries of standard conventions.

#### 7. Versatile Thinker (see the Complex Thinking Standards)

- use a variety of complex & creative reasoning strategies;
- extend, refine, and use knowledge;
